All proposals scheduled for public hearings shall be duly advertised in accordance with charter provisions, i.e., the Commission shall afford the public an opportunity to be heard at a time and place to be specified in a notice of hearing to be published in The City Record for ten days of publication of The City Record immediately preceding and including the date of hearing. (Detailed information on items appearing in this calendar may be obtained by contacting the Department of City Planning.)

Note—Matters scheduled for public hearing by the City Planning Commission usually appear in three calendars: first in Section I, (Scheduling Dates for Future Public Hearings), second in Section II, (Public Hearings), and third in Section III, (Reports). Matters scheduled for public hearing by Community Boards appear in a separate calendar available in the Calendar Information Office.

CALENDARS: Any member of a Community Planning Board, any civic association or non-profit organization may write the Calendar Officer of the Commission to be placed on the mailing list to receive the Comprehensive City Planning Calendar which consists of the City Planning Commission Public Meeting Calendar, Supplemental Calendar and Special Meeting Calendar, and Community Board Public Hearing Notices. Calendars are also available to the public in the Calendar Information Office, 2 Lafayette Street, Room 1614, New York, N.Y. 10007.
