Pursuant to Section 25-306 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York, the Landmarks Preservation Commission hereby approves certain alterations to the subject premises as proposed in your application completed on August 13, 2019.

The approved work consists of exterior work including the installation of temporary illuminated signage ("JetBlue" and four (4) logos) and metal framing attached to the existing Pepsi Cola Sign structure, which will be removed on or before October 1, 2019, as described and shown in a letter prepared by Carl Chaleski dated July 9, 2019; a rendering; three diagrams; existing conditions photographs; and drawings labeled 1 through 5, dated July 22, 2019, and prepared by Landmark Unlimited Incorporated, all submitted as components of the application.

In reviewing this proposal, the Commission notes that the Pepsi-Cola Sign Designation Report describes 2-01 47th Road (aka 4-09 47th Road) as a structure, manufactured by the General Outdoor Advertising Company, and built in 1940.

With regard to the proposal, the Commission finds, in accordance with the provisions set forth in Title 63 of the Rules of the City of New York, Section 2-05 for Temporary Installations. Based on these findings, the work is approved.

The Commission has reviewed the application and these drawings and finds that the work will have no effect on significant protected features of the building.

Other work or amendments to this filing must be reviewed and approved separately. The applicant is hereby put on notice that performing or maintaining any work not explicitly authorized by this permit may make the applicant liable for criminal and/or civil penalties, including imprisonment and fine.
